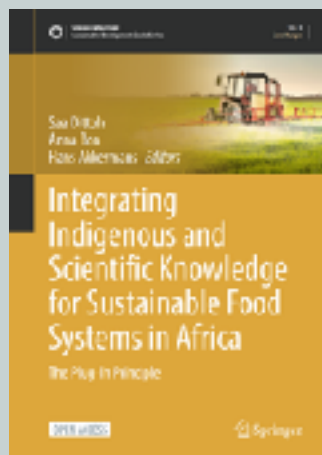
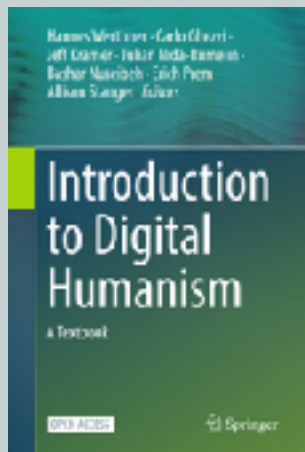
- Digital Decade and Declaration Digital Rights and Principles (14/15 December 2022)
- *EURIDICE offers high-quality education with interdisciplinary content that demonstrably puts people at the centre of the digital transformation (Declaration Ch. I), see for example the study plan in D2.1.*
- *EURIDICE promotes solidarity and inclusion (Declaration Ch. II) through its challenge-based collaborative educational philosophy and environment (Collaboratorium, D6.1).*
- *Of further importance for inclusion is that EURIDICE caters for learners with non-ICT backgrounds. It avoids financial obstacles related to socioeconomic background or class of learners, as it has very affordable tuition fees, and a solid grant program for student blended mobility in a way that fosters learner community formation.*

- State of the Digital Decade 2025 / Monitoring the European Declaration on Digital Rights and Principles (16June2025)
- *[ctd.] Freedom of Choice (Declaration Ch III): the sociotechnical issues associated with bias and fairness of AI algorithms are inherent part of EURIDICE's curriculum. That AI should serve as a tool for people, with the ultimate aim of increasing human well-being, is a foundational principle across EURIDICE.*
- *Participation in the digital public space (Declaration Ch. IV): EURIDICE prepares learners well for this, in view of its central educational themes of Digital Society, Social Innovation and Global Citizenship.*
- *EURIDICE pays ample attention to transversal skills such as critical thinking*
- *Bridging digital divides (gender, geographic, colour, urban/rural, global) is a theme addressed in several places of EURIDICE education.*

- UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)



- *EURIDICE contributes particularly to SDG-4 and SDG-17, in view of its educational philosophy: putting the human and human values in the centre of the digital transformation*



- DG-CNECT Expert stakeholder consultations on future programmes – MFF, Brussels, 10-11 July 2025. Recommendation:

“Reinforce **interdisciplinary** R&D training including support for **AI+ethics+domain** training.”
